We also grow a wide range of plants indigenous to the Otway Ranges forest and coast.

Please contact us if you would like a list of Otway species.. We use biodynamic practices in the nursery and garden and have A grade demeter classification. As many plants are grown in small numbers please list alternatives, unless otherwise advised we will select substitutes.

The plants will be packaged and labeled with utmost care and although we do not accept responsibility once plants have left us we will do our best to rectify any problems. Plants will be sent by post on Monday unless you make alternative arrangements. Please include payment and postage with your order.
