The garden receives no additional watering, only rainfall, so is very dry in summer and autumn, but can be very wet in winter and spring. We also grow a wide range of plants indigenous to the Otway Ranges forest and coast.

**Note:** We use biodynamic practices in the nursery and garden and have A grade Demeter classification.

As many plants are grown in small numbers please list alternatives, unless otherwise advised we will select substitutes.

The plants will be packaged and labeled with utmost care and although we do not accept responsibility once plants have left us we will do our best to rectify any problems.
